## World Class Roller Coasters!

Kings Island features 15 world-class, innovative and record-breaking roller coasters, including the Diamondback – the tallest, fastest and meanest roller coaster to ever strike the park, and the Beast – the longest wooden roller coaster in the world!

---

- **Diamondback** – Kings Island’s newest roller coaster stands 230 feet at its highest point with a first drop of 215 feet at a 74-degree angle. Riders will snake their way around 5,282 feet at speeds up to 80 miles per hour! This steel monster has 10 vertical drops overall, including drops of 193, 131, 129, 110 and 106 feet.
- **Firehawk** – This innovative flying coaster propels willing test pilots 115 feet in the air and through five inversions at more than 50 mph – all while facing the ground experiencing the inconceivable feeling of human flight!
- **The Beast** – This legendary ride is arguably the greatest roller coaster ever built! Celebrating 30 years of terror in 2009, the Beast still stands today as the world’s longest wooden roller coaster at 7,400 feet.
- **Son of Beast** – This world-record breaking roller coaster elevates the classic wood coaster experience to a new level, taking riders higher than ever before and racing them around more than 7,000 feet of wooden track faster than ever before.
- **The Racer** – The Park’s original roller coaster is a classic out-and-back, traditional wooden-racing roller coaster and credited for re-igniting the coaster-building boom in the early 1970’s.
- **Adventure Express** – This roller coaster takes families on an exhilarating runaway adventure through four theme tunnels and two lift hills.
- **Vortex** – This one-of-a-kind steel looping roller coaster thrills riders by sending them upside-down an incredible six times! Vortex was the first roller coaster in the world with six inversions.
- **Invertigo** – The only steel looping, forward and backward, face-to-face roller coaster in the Midwest. Riders shoot up a 138-foot lift hill before being sent flying at speeds reaching 55 mph through three inversions forward and then backwards.
- **Flight of Fear** – The first linear induction motor LIM-launched roller coaster in the world catapults riders from 0 to 54 mph in just four seconds on a heart-pounding adventure in total darkness through four inversions.
- **Backlot Stunt Coaster** – Experience what it’s like to be a stunt car driver on this high speed, special effects, and roller coaster adventure.
- **Flight Deck** – This fun-filled suspended roller coaster takes guests on an unforgettable jet ride.

- **Fairly Odd Coaster** – This classic roller coaster opened with the Park in 1972 and brings adult-sized thrills to pint-sized thrill seekers.
- **Rugrats Runaway Adventure** – The world’s first inverted roller coaster provides adult-sized thrills to pint-sized thrill seekers.
- **Little Bill’s Giggle Coaster** – A miniature steel roller coaster complete with great hills and dips for young park guests and their families.
- **Avatar The Last Airbender:** Step inside the mystical air temple pagoda and get ready to embark on an epic adventure. Ride waves of air on a speeding sled coaster with Aang as your guide.

Kings Island is owned and operated by Cedar Fair Entertainment Company, a publicly traded partnership that is listed for trading on The New York Stock Exchange under the symbol “FUN.” In addition to Kings Island, Cedar Fair owns and operates ten other amusement parks, six water parks, one indoor water park resort and five hotels. Cedar Fair also operates the Gilroy Gardens Family Theme Park in Gilroy, Calif. under a management contract.
